A week from today...Tuesday February 28th is the FSA Writing Test for 4th, 5th, and 6th!!!Do NOT miss this day, and please make sure your child eats breakfast and is here on time. Tardy students must remain in office until testing is over!

****Students must be in their seat no later than 8:20 in order to be counted present and not tardy.**Any students who are tardy (not in seat by 8:20) will miss the test for that day and will have to remain in the office until testing has ended.**

May 2nd and 4th: FSA Science 5th grade

****It is very important that your child(ren) are present during this time!**Please try to avoid making any out of town plans during this time and schedule any appointments after school hours. Visitors will not be allowed on campus during testing.We ask for your cooperation on helping your child attend school on time, every day. Please remember school doors open at 7:00 a.m. for students in before and aftercare, 7:45 for students eating breakfast, and 8:00 for all other students, with school starting at 8:15. Please make sure you give your child plenty of time to come in and walk to class before 8:20. Any child **entering their homeroom** after 8:20 will be considered tardy. Any student arriving at school at or after 8:20 is required to be signed in by the person dropping them off. No student is allowed to sign themselves in.
****Children arriving late for school will not be signed up for school lunch UNLESS you notify the front office before 8:45. After 8:45 you will need to provide lunch for your child.**

**Homework packets are sent home every Friday and are due on the following Thursday. This applies to every student 1st grade – 6th grades.

**Parents, we need your help to impress upon your child the importance of taking responsibility for their education. "i-Ready" is a computer based monitoring program used throughout the county, and is set up so your child may access it from home as well as school. "i-Ready" is a tool used to monitor your child's progression and help them master math and reading skills.

Lessons completed and passed are used in the grading process.

When you have someone, other than the normal person, picking up your child you must let the office know before 2:00 p.m. Please remind your child's pick-up person they will need to show ID whether they are on or are not on your child's pick up list. Your child will not be allowed to leave the property with anyone even if they are on your list without you notifying the office either by note or a phone call. If your child is NOT picked up by 3pm they will be placed in aftercare and the \$10 fee will be due at pick up. (\$10 per student \$5 for each additional sibling)
